Eye sight of a woman partially blind in left eye (from a mini stroke 16 years ago) healed followed by prayers from her friends around the table. She was overcome by an experience of God's love, that He would do this for her.

Young man who had hip/leg pain from car accident many years ago responded to a word of knowledge about hip and leg pain in right leg. His leg was turned outward for years because of the way things healed, and he had pain throughout. While the people at his table were praying the pain left, and he realized he could stand and walk with his leg pointed forward normally. On his own he chose to forgive the 2 drivers involved. Praise God!

Woman with pain in her foot from a surgery didn't go join a small group when we did breakouts because the pain in her feet made it hurt to get up or stand. The Lord sovereignly healed her feet while sitting at the table alone — with no one praying for her!! No pain!

Older woman with arthritis all over her body, particularly bad in her back. When praying she remembered a traumatic memory as a kid. Shortly after that traumatic event her leg was twisted, and foot pointed in wrong direction. The doctors suggested it was psychological, so her parents took her to a hypnotist as a kid for healing. God healed the memory and she confessed and renounced her involvement in the hypnosis. Her back was healed completely. No pain! She was dancing around in joy!

Woman with numbness and pain in her left cheek, healed. No pain. She also had a left eye issue we prayed for with pupil not dilating/constricting. Not clear how the eye has resolved, but the pain in her face left and she experienced God's love.

In group exercise when people around the tables prayed for each other in a room of about 175, when asked many, many people waved indicating they had experienced some healing or experience of God's presence during group prayers.

Woman asked God who she needed to forgive. She knew she was blocked by unforgiveness but wasn't sure who it was. Her mom had died when she was 8, and her dad wasn't great. She assumed it might be her dad again, but she had already been through lots forgiveness for dad. Instead God said she needed to forgive her mom - for dying and leaving her - which had never occurred to her. She forgave her today. Felt lots of weight come off her when she did. Today is also the 56th anniversary of her mom's death!

God's love for me, is still washing over me today. When I pulled up to the Student Center and saw you all outside waiting for me to arrive with my dog my heart was so moved. Each one of them laid hands on her and prayed for her. I'm excited to see how God works in Bree's life. The

generosity of the team to present all day long followed by a worship service in the evening yet still on their lunch break minister deeply to me and my itty-bitty Malinois... I just don't have words for how much that meant to me. Prayer is not easy work. I am thanking God for all that I received. The answers to prayer for many people and for the many wonderful experiences I had this weekend will continue to unfold for a long time.

All I can say is WOW - I'm so blessed to have met CHI and been introduced to the healing prayer ministry at CAFO in September. That "chance" encounter (which we know is not chance AT ALL but the Lord's divine work) has become a defining moment in my personal testimony.

The classes that you offered at CAFO were absolutely amazing. Healing from Trauma through Prayer and Experience Healing from Trauma through Prayer. I so needed these. The Lord brought to my remembrance that I had buried things from my childhood. And that He wanted to heal what those circumstances had planted there. Thank you. God Bless you all!

After you all prayed for me as group, I started to feel slowly better over the next few days. I had a few days of pain-free and then another week of it getting bad again. Instead of getting down and concerned about it, I prayed and the Holy Spirit led me to "replay" the prayer time spent with you all again. I focused on that, I pressed into that and put my mind over to Jesus to mold and embrace. In about 20 minutes the pain cleared, and it's been awesome ever since.

I had never heard of the Christian Healing Institute but one day I was out shopping and I heard the Lord put the name in my mind. I parked my car and as I was walking through the parking lot, "Christian Healing Institute" came clearly into my mind. And so I googled it and THAT'S how I found you! Praise be to God our Father, the creator of heaven and earth. Thank you Father for Jesus, for making a way, for being our God who loves us and give us truth.

I wanted to let you know that I received some kind of physical healing last night during the demonstrations. I think it was kind of like the woman who said, If I can just touch His garment, I can be healed. I'm crying right now as I write this. Through the night and into this morning, I have been led to vacate all judgments that I have made against people for whatever.

I just wanted to give you an update. I wrote to you that I was having crushing anxiety on Zoom meetings. You encouraged me to stick with the class. Two weeks ago I had my OSL group pray for me, and that night you all prayed for us to receive the Holy Spirit. My anxiety left me, and I received the gift of tongues. I am still an introvert, but I was the first person that spoke at the end of the 12:30 Zoom call today - so I have come a long way.

During the singing of the Lord's prayer, I was suddenly reminded of my confirmation when I was young. I remembered kneeling before the Bishop and he was pressing his ring to my forehead, which is part of the ceremony I went through. In my mind, as the Bishop was pressing the ring, I heard the Lord say, "Mine!" Subsequently, as Chuck was praying for the release of the Spirit, I started sobbing--REALLY gut-wrenching wails--as I was reminded of my father's death when I was 10. Shortly after starting to wail, the word "bitterness" came to mind. Wailing, I didn't really know what to do, so I just started praying that the Spirit would remove any root of bitterness that may have taken hold and that the void would be filled with good soil that would grow the fruits of the Spirit. Continuing to sob, as Chuck started praying for more in-filling of the Spirit, my mind moved to how my relationship with my mother changed so dramatically after my father's death, and I started wailing again. The word "bitterness" came to mind again, so, still crying, I prayed for me to release that, for it to be gone. Then, as the prayer time continued, I had a third very recent painful memory come to mind, with me, again, asking the Spirit to remove any bitterness. It's hard to exactly explain the timing but while each of these memories and the prayers were going on, woven in with my requests and wailing, bits of helpful scripture and songs would come to mind, e.g., "He who has begun a good work in you, will carry it on to completion." and "Rejoice in the Lord always, and, again, I say rejoice." I was still crying and trying to catch my breath when the prayer session ended, and I am not exactly sure what happened. I hadn't thought of my confirmation is decades, and I don't usually dwell on my father's death as it was a difficult time. I awoke this morning feeling somehow a little

lighter in spirit. I'm not sure why, but I'm tearing up even as I write this. The prayer time was profoundly good for me, and I trust God that all is well with my soul.

I LOVED hearing the two testimonies about anxiety, and the triple whammy of the one woman being freed from it (and emboldened to share publicly with the group!), filled with the holy spirit and the gift of tongues AND getting a word about her kidneys! ABUNDANCE. So good.
